- Provide leadership in interpreting legislation and the California Education Code regarding Adapted Physical Education.
- Work with the California Department of Education Special Education Division on projects that relate to Adapted Physical Education.
- Solicit nominations and select recipients for the Teacher of the Year & Exemplary Program awards.
- Solicit nominations and select recipients for the Cultural Diversity and Julius Spizzirri Student Scholarships.
